Center

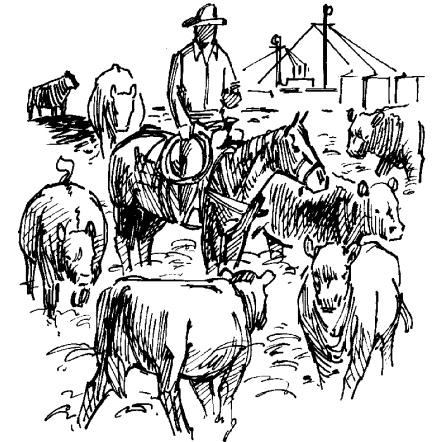
The Center is located on the Oklahoma Panhandle University Farm. There are signs on both Highway 54 and County Road 23 to the Center.
